At March 2011, Sonning Common had a slightly lower mix of residents in one-person households than elsewhere.

Sonning Common had a slightly higher mix of residents aged 65+ in one-person households than elsewhere.

Sonning Common had a slightly higher mix of residents in multi-person households than elsewhere.

Sonning Common had a much higher mix of residents in multi-person households with two adults (of whom at least one was aged 65+) and no children than elsewhere.

Sonning Common had a higher mix of residents in multi-person households with two adults with 1 or 2 children than elsewhere.

Sonning Common had a lower mix of residents in multi-person households with two adults (aged 16-64) with no children than elsewhere.

Sonning Common had a lower mix of residents in multi-person households with two adults and 3+ children than elsewhere.
