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CONCLUSIONS

At March 2011, Sonning Common had a lower mix of residents in one-person households than elsewhere. (Less 18-34 yr olds and lack of appropriate housing stock) Sonning Common had a rather higher mix of residents of 65+ in one-person households than elsewhere. Sonning Common had a rather higher mix of residents in family households than elsewhere. Sonning Common had a lower mix of residents living in "Other household types" than elsewhere.

Sonning Common had a similar mix of residents living in households with children who remain dependent as elsewhere.
