CONCLUSIONS

The Household Reference Person was formerly referred to as the head of the household.

In Sonning Common only 5% of households were headed (referenced) by someone aged under 35 - much less than elsewhere.

In Sonning Common 38% of households were headed by someone aged 65 or overunder 35 - more than elsewhere.

Single person households in Sonning Common represented 24% of the mix - slightly less than elsewhere - but on average in larger propeties

Two person households (without dependent children) in Sonning Common represented 47% of the mix - a bit more than elsewhere - and again on average in larger properties

Two person households with dependent children in Sonning Common represented 29% of the mix - in line with elsewhere
